- Money for Shepherd Shop

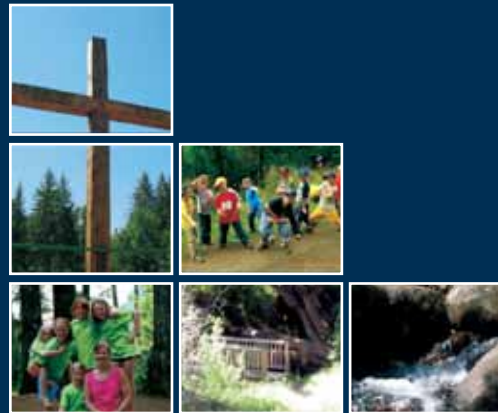
DO NOT BRING:

- Tobacco products

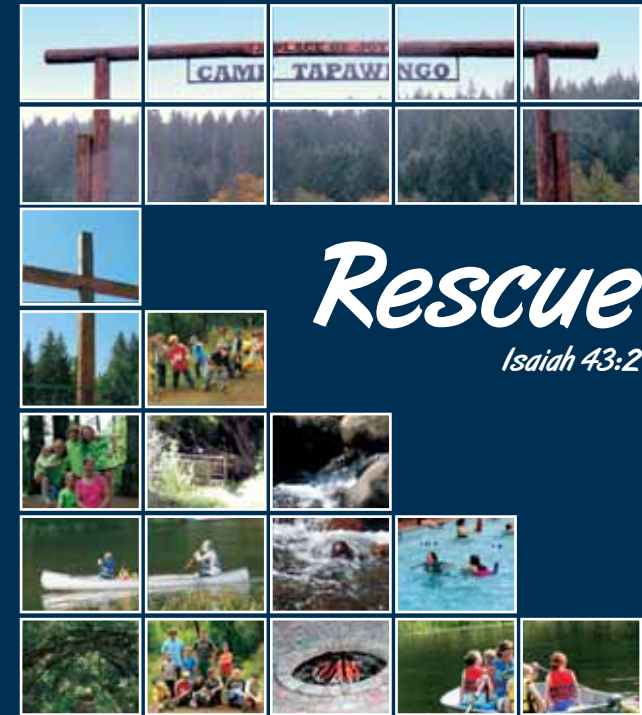

PARENT:

It is your responsibility to make registration deadlines for the camp your child is attending. These dates are necessary to meet food delivery deadlines and to finalize the necessary counselor-to-camper ratio. Please mail your registration directly to Camp Tapawingo. If your church is providing a scholarship for your child, it is your responsibility to notify them of the camp your child is attending.

WAITING LIST:

TRANSPORTATION:
